Software upgrade to Version 6.8 is available to customers and is offered free of charge to customers that have purchased the AudioCodes Enhanced Support package.

Version 6.8 contains many new enhancements and features. Some of the feature highlights are listed below (a complete list of the new features is provided in the Release Notes):

- Mediant 1000B number of spans expanded to 8 T1s and 6 E1s
- Mediant 4000 session capacity increased to 5,000 sessions and 1,650 transcoding sessions
- Security-related features, such as dynamic blacklist and alarms on attacks
- Real-time improvement in QoS by dynamically switching coders and routes, based on self-measured link quality
- Active Directory (AD) enhancements providing Windows login, redundant Active Directory, and flexible queries
- Multiple certificate domains support for hosted service providers
- Voice recording using the SIPREC protocol
- Cloud Resilience Package (CRP) for hosted services
- EMS:
 - Increased capacity to 5,000 devices
 - New added devices - Lync SBA, Mediant 500, and software SBCs
 - Active Directory support for user authentication
- Session Experience Manager (SEM):
 - Multi-tenancy - each tenant's data cannot be seen by other tenants
 - Increased capacity to 3,000 devices and 300 Call Attempts per Second (CAPS)
 - Scheduled reports
 - Monitoring of specific VLAN/Subnet
