Software Update for AudioCodes SBC & Gateway Series: Version 7.2.150

Dear Partners and Customers,

AudioCodes announces the release of Software Version 7.2.150 for its Voice-over-IP (VoIP) media gateways and session border controllers (SBC).

Some of the major features introduced in this version include:

- Mediant 9000 session capacity increase to 50,000 sessions (from 24,000)
- Mediant 9000 can now be ordered with a four 10GE and eight 1GE interfaces
- Mediant 800 session capacity increase to 400 sessions (from 250)
- Mediant Virtual Edition SBC running on KVM with SR-IOV reaches 24,000 sessions
- Mediant 500L now supports analog interfaces (up to four FXS and FXO ports)
- SBC Configuration Wizard is integrated in the Web GUI, allowing fast SBC configuration using pre-tested interoperability templates
- SBC updates presence (e.g., busy) of non-Skype for Business clients in Skype for Business environments
- Pulse dialing support on MP-1288
- Local storage of logs on Mediant 9000 and Mediant VE
